Please Note: This will be withheld if any relevant person (including any guarantor(s)) withdraw from the tenancy, fail a Right to Rent check, provide materially significant false or misleading information, or fail to sign their tenancy agreement (and / or Deed of Guarantee) within 15 calendar days (or other Deadline for Agreement as mutually agreed in writing).

If the Tenant is a company (PLC, Ltd or LLP) an administration fee is payable to reserve the property instead of a holding deposit. Please see section below titled 'Company Tenant'

Change of Sharer (Tenant's Request)

 $\pounds50$ (inc VAT) per replacement tenant or any reasonable costs incurred if higher. To cover the administration of taking Landlord's instructions, new Tenant referencing and Right to Rent checks, deposit registration as well as the preparation and execution of new legal documents.

Variation of Contract (Tenant's Request) $\pounds 50$ (inc VAT) To cover the costs associated with taking Landlord's instructions as well as the preparation and execution of new legal documents.

Early Termination

Should the Tenant wish to leave their contract early, they shall be liable for the Landlord's costs in reletting the property as well as all rent due under the tenancy until the start date of the replacement tenancy.

These costs will be no more than the maximum amount of rent outstanding on the tenancy. Please refer to our <u>website</u> for details of Landlord fees.

Lost Keys

Tenants are liable for the actual cost of replacing any lost key(s) or other security device(s). If the loss results in locks needing to be changed, the actual costs of a locksmith, new lock and replacement keys for the Tenant, landlord and any other persons requiring keys will be charged to the Tenant.

If extra costs are incurred there may be a charge of £15 per hour (inc. VAT) for the time taken replacing lost key(s) or other security device(s).
